National Assessment Program - Literacy and Numeracy (NAPLAN)

The NAPLAN is the annual national assessment for all students in Years 7 and 9. NAPLAN is designed to measure the educational growth of students over time, ensuring teaching and learning for students is progressing. The NAPLAN also provides the school with information about how our educational programs are working and what areas need to be prioritised for improvement. The best way you can help your child's preparation is to reassure your child that NAPLAN is just one part of the school program and urge them to do the best that Tuesday May 2 was the first session of the they can.

The tests will be held from Tuesday 9 May to Thursday 11 May. Catch up tests for students that have been absent from school on the Tuesday, Wednesday and Thursday, are scheduled on Friday 12 May. All students will be given the opportunity over the four days to complete all aspects of the testing program. The school does not have the discretion to vary the program delivery days.
