Assistant Principals Report

Respectful Relationships commitment

Along with the other schools in the Federation, our school has established a Respectful Relationships leadership team to help guide the implementation of Respectful Relationships. The team will be involved in and committed to - identifying, leading and resourcing actions to promote gender equality and implementing respectful relationships across the school.

So far, the team has attended identifying family violence and gender equity training and undertaken a baseline gender assessment using the Department of Education's tool. All staff within the Federation have attended a Respectful Relationships induction session. This is to better understand the drivers of violence against women as being gender inequality and the adherence to rigid gender stereotypes.
