  - All Students must be able to manage their own bags no porters have been included in this cost.


# Nagoya

#### Passports:

Passports must be valid for a minimum of 6 months beyond the expected departure from Japan. On entry to Japan passports are stamped 'temporary visitor'.

#### • Visa's:

Visa's are not required for stays less than 90 days.

#### • Immunisation:

As of February 2012, no vaccinations are required for entering Japan. Japan has a very similar vaccination schedule to Australia. Tetnus should be up to date. However we are not doctors and you should seek medical advice from your doctor regarding immunisation.


