Drama Workshop

Five WMYC students attended an Arts workshop at the Cube, on the last Thursday of Term 3. Cale Broydell, Charlie Roach and Bella Rivett from Felltimber together with Blake Wood and Jacob Hawkins from Huon, participated in a workshop facilitated by Creative Director Kate Stones, Music Director Eliza Hull and Performance Facilitator Sam Thomas from theatre company "Creatability" prior to the performance of "No Hands" that evenina.

The workshop was designed to share the creative processes utilized by the theatre group. Students were led through "Creatability's" developmental process, using improvisation and impromptu sound and music, to uncover expressive potential in the journey to create a performance.

Our students got to experience first-hand the creative processes utilised. The experience was enjoyable, enriching and empowering. It was amazing to see them growing as individuals and performers. The day culminated with the students performing, bringing their ideas to life in the wonderful Cube space.



Some of the students were fortunate enough to see the performance "No Hands" that night. The performance was powerful and poignant, highlighting the importance of inclusion and the beauty of the human spirit.

Here are some student recollections of the workshop:

Charles Roach: It was a great opportunity to learn a lot about acting and different methods of developing performance: plus I got to be on the news that night!

I particularly liked improvising and presenting our performance at the end-which was full of surprises.

Cale Broydell: It was a safe, friendly environment to experiment in and I felt confident having a go, plus it was great fun. I also liked meeting two people from the community who participated and the two Huon kids.

Bella Rivett: I really loved an exercise we did with voice, where as a group we brought our individual sounds in to a cacophony of collective voices. It was awesome and thanks to Ms O'Shea for organising this.

It is fantastic when our students have opportunities like this, to work with professional groups outside of the College and to work in a different environment like the Cube. Opportunities like this can ignite lifelong passions and even career paths.
