Oz Comicon 2019

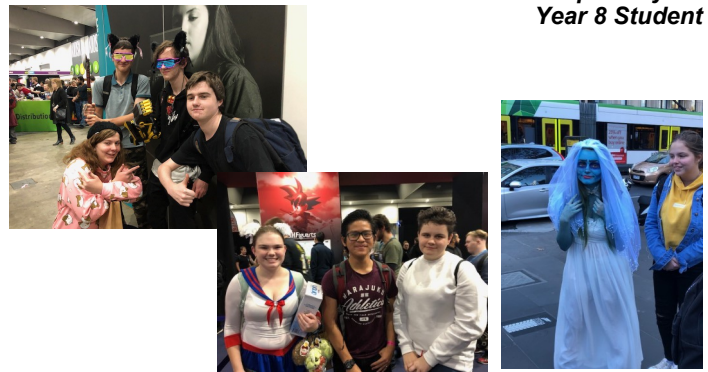
