Transition

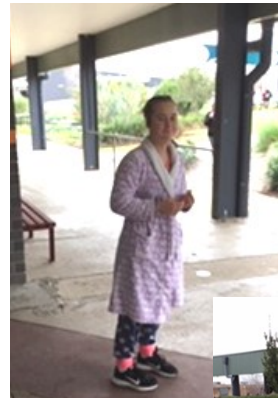
2021 6 into 7 Transition
