

Transition to Remote Learning

In the event of a school closure, the following measures for curriculum delivery are proposed. The situation continues to evolve, and we will need to learn and adapt our response along the way.

Context notes:

- School closure is likely to be extended if it happens, notice may be short.
- Any local closure is likely to be part of a state-wide shutdown, so we anticipate accompanying policies and modifications to be made to the delivery of the Victorian Curriculum.

Proposed virtual delivery plan:

- Timetabled class times to remain in place for students to follow from home. However, the sessions will be shortened to 40min.

Period 1 – 9.00am

Period 2 – 10.00am

Period 3 – 11.00am

Period 4 – 12.00pm

- **Microsoft Teams and D2L** should be the preferred platform for communication.
- Teachers will schedule a **Microsoft Teams** call for the beginning of each period.
- Teachers will use the **Activity Feed on D2L course pages** to set the work to be completed for each session.
- Students and families can use **Microsoft Teams** to post questions for the teacher.
- Parents/guardians may use email as a form of communication with teachers.
