This letter is to inform you of the upcoming NAPLAN assessment for students in Year 7 and 9, scheduled 11th-13th of March, with catchup testing scheduled for the following week.

At Wodonga Middle Years College, we are dedicated to preparing your child for these assessments and using them as one of many tools to understand and support each student's learning journey. Recognising that while NAPLAN is an important assessment, it will be just one of the various assessments we use to evaluate your child's progress.

Please note that the timetable for your child's participation in the NAPLAN tests will be provided closer to the testing window. This schedule will detail the specific dates and times for each test. In preparation for NAPLAN, students will be provided opportunities to familiarise themselves with the format of the assessments to ensure they are comfortable and confident in taking the test. As NAPLAN is conducted online. We encourage all students to ensure they have organised their own approved device.
